April 2014, there were 26 collisions in comparisor Year to date in Altadena there were 78 for 2015, as compared to 79 for 2014. Citations issued were 48 in April 2015, and year to date in 2015, there are 271 citations issued. There are no fatalities in Altadena for 2015 and there are a total of 8 DUI arrests year to date.	amage on. ued

District and local agencies concerning the drought issue. We are at the worst drought in history. The Governor in response has asked for a 25% mandatory reduction in statewide water use. Metropolitan has asked for a 15% reduction in imported water use. There are numerous conservation devices. Restrictions on times when watering can and cannot occur and when watering must cease in response to the drought.

For CT 4611 there is Incumbent Councilperson Amy Cienfuegos, Justin Robertson, and Otis Triplett. For CT 4612 there is Anne Lansing. For CT 4613 there is Vahe Atchabahian and Incumbent Councilperson Sylvia Vega. Motion by Election Chair Ezieme to approve the Candidates that will be considered for election on June 2 and 6, 2015. Seconded by Patricia Sutherlen-unanimous. Election Chair Ezieme asks for volunteers to help at the Polling locations which are at the Altadena Community Center, Altadena Library, the Coffee Gallery, Farnsworth Park, Gordy's Garage, Loma Alta Park, Mint Leaf Restaurant, Podley Properties and Ralphs Market. On June 2, 2015, the Polling location will be at the Altadena Library. However, if any community member wants to volunteer there are qualifications to being a volunteer. A volunteer has to be 18 years are older, not the person nor related to the person running for election, and a resident of Altadena. Finally, if any Candidate wants their Candidate Information to be updated or changed, such information or changes must be received by May 29 2015, by 4:30 p.m. to the Election Chair. As to the Ballot boxes – the Altadena Sheriff's Department will pick up the ballot boxes on Tuesday and maintain them at the Sheriff's station for safekeeping. The ballot counting will start at 5:00 p.m. on June 6, 2015.
