7. Presentation:

Project R2014-01586 located at 183-295 E, Palm St. Presentation was made by developer, Austin Richie. Property was purchased 3 years ago, original purpose was to build a school. Current purpose is to build single family homes. Tract map has been presented to the County. Revisions are being presented tonight.

Based on comments, concerns of Council Members are:

Trees (what is being removed, what is being planted), density, lack of water conservation, increased traffic, need to see rendering so can visualize the project.

Based on comments, concerns of the surrounding community are: Compatibility with the current neighborhood (mix of single/2story homes), density, trees, traffic on East Palm. Community wants it known that it does want development, but this needs to fit into the neighborhood.
