#### 3. PUBLIC SAFETY REPORTS

3.	California Highway Patrol Officer Mike reports concerning the Best Fest and indicated that it was a successful event. Officer Mike also indicates that there were complaints received concerning the road closure on Mariposa. The CHP tried to accommodate everyone and Best Fest. Traffic collisions in Altadena for September 2015 were 20. Of those, 15 were property damage, only 5 with injury and 1 was DUI related. Year to date in Altadena there were 184 traffic collisions for 2015. Citations issued were slightly down at 34, and there were a total of 2 DUI arrests.					
3.2	Altadena Sheriff's Station Lt. Marquez reports that there was a 18.1% drop in crime (year to date in Altadena) for 2015 – which means there are 87 fewer crimes in Altadena from last year 2014. The 5 year reduction in Altadena in the crime rate is at 50.1% which is 402 fewer crimes from 5 years ago. Lt Marquez indicates that with Halloween approaching additional resources will be deployed by the Altadena Sheriff's Station.					
	3.2.1 Captain Reed indicates that he was transferred to the Sheriff's Information Bureau. Captain Reed thanks the community, Council, Supervisor Antonovich's Office and Assemblymember Holden for the time he spent as Captain. Captain Reed also introduced Captain Stuckey. Captain Stuckey indicates that she looks forward to working with the community of Altadena.					
	CERT Karen Gibson reports concerning CERT which stands for Community Emergency Response Team. Karen Gibson also indicates that CERT was present at 4 or 5 block parties. MAP YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD has been complete in 5 or 6 areas and CERT had a presence at BEST FEST in October 2015. Also, CERT has two (2) new volunteers and asks the community to also volunteer.

#### 7. CENSUS TRACT REPORTS

4603.01 Judy Matthews/Damon Hobdy. Councilmember Judy Matthews thanks the community, council and representatives for their encouragement, cards, flowers and get well wishes. Councilmember Matthews also thanks Elliot Gold and his wife for their well wishes and support. The Annual Meet and Greet will be held on November 7, 2015, at Loma Alta Park from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. There are a total of 8 presenters confirmed as of this date. The issues addressed will be from the responses of surveys sent out but all community members are welcomed not just from 4603.01.

4603.02 Gloria Sanyika/Dean Cooper. Councilmember Sanyika indicates that 4603.02 has scheduled a rain water harvesting and rain barrel sale on December 12, 2015, at Loma Alta Park from 9 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. This event is put on to encourage local residents to be more proactive concerning the drought and to address drought concerns. There will be a 1 hour class on rain water harvesting, how to install a rain barrel, etc. When a resident purchases a rain barrel for \$85.00 you will get a \$75.00 rebate.
