Chris O'Malley, Land Use Committee Member, updated the town council and the community on the results of his outreach to the community. He received a mostly positive response with some residents having no opinion.

Councilmember Gloria Sanyika made a motion that CUP 2015000095, R2015-02353 Verizon & Sprint wireless facility, located 2949 Lincoln Ave be approved with the following listed conditions included in the recommendation:

- Work on the install is to be done during business hours: 8am-5pm M-F
- Generator is to meet all California air pollution, noise and earthquake building laws. Generator testing is to be scheduled during business hours (8am-5pm M-F)
- Verizon shall co-locate their equipment with Sprint on a single mono-eucalyptus tower
- Tower to be check and repaired at least once per quarter
- Network operators telephone number visible and posted on site

A vote was taken. The motion passed unanimously.
