

**STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS OF DONALD W. McCORMICK**

To the Altadena Town Council:

I first moved to Altadena in the early 1990's and lived on North Catherine Road for about twenty years, raising two children there. Our house was a block from Christmas Tree Lane. I moved to the east coast for a few years for family reasons and sold that house, then moved back three years ago and am renting a house on Saint James Place from another Altadena resident. I shop at Altadena stores, take my laundry to Bryan's on Lake Street, buy tools and hardware from Altadena Hardware down a block from the Community Center, and am a member of St. Elizabeth's Catholic Church. Before COVID, on the weekends, I hiked up the Sam Merrill Trail at the top of Lake Street or the Old Mt. Wilson Road off of Altadena Drive.
