DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

A **DISASTER** (opposed to an emergency) is a situation in which 911 is overwhelmed and unable to answer or respond to calls for help. In such a situation, individuals and neighborhoods need to be prepared and able to help themselves and each other medically and mentally for a length of time – possibly two weeks or longer. Do you have enough water, food and medical supplies for your family and pets? Do you know the resources, skills and equipment inventory in your neighborhood?

MYN'S PURPOSE is to educate and empower small groups of neighbors, and prepare them to be self-sufficient. Emergency personnel nationwide are encouraging participation from those who may be willing to host a training in their home or organize hosted group trainings for their immediate neighbors -- 15-30 households -- determined by the reasonable group who can be accessed and attended to within the first crucial hour after a disaster. Learn how to get yourself and your family prepared, and organize a **DISASTER PLAN** for your neighborhood. We – your volunteer Altadena MYN Team -- will provide meeting materials and staff support!
