



Los Angeles County Bicycle Master Plan Update

Safe. Equitable. Planned for you.

Overview

Los Angeles County Public Works (PW) is updating the Los Angeles County Bicycle Master Plan (BMP). The current BMP was last updated in 2012 and established a vision for the future of biking in the County. The BMP will serve as a guide for the development of safe and accessible bikeways and paths within unincorporated LA County and along County flood control district channels. The BMP will:

- Propose new bikeways
- Revisit the feasibility of unconstructed bikeways from the 2012 plan
- Incorporate new policies to share bikeway facilities with micro-mobility devices
- Identify first/last mile bikeway improvements to further connect to transit stations and bus stops
- Prepare for the Programmatic Environmental Impact Report

The project will engage with community members, community-based organizations (CBOs), and advisory committees to develop an inclusive and representative BMP. The BMP Update will be finalized in early 2025.

Equity. Invest in underserved, pollution-burdened communities that are most dependent on active transportation.



Safety. Prioritize bicycle projects that improve the safety of our streets.



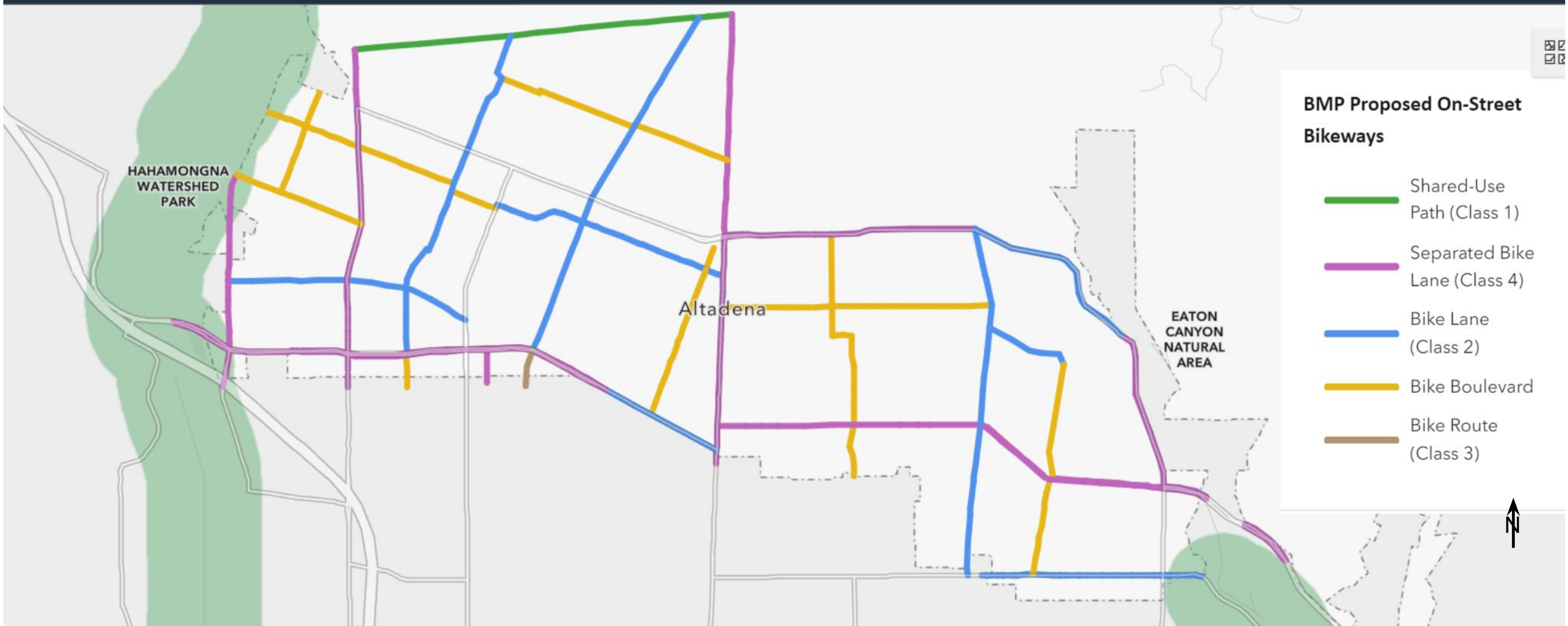
Mode Shift. Increase the number of biking and multimodal trips.
